

## Early Childhood Connections: Public School Introduction to Project Approach - Building a Foundation

## Professional Development Opportunity

Public School Fact Sheet: 2017

Kohl Children's Museum is seeking preschool through third grade teachers to learn about and implement the Project Approach in their classrooms using Kohl Children's Museum as a resource and learning laboratory. The program includes a professional development component for teachers, interactive learning experiences for students both in the classroom and at Kohl Children's Museum, an in-school parent/child activity, and a family event and family passes to the museum. Programming content will address the Illinois Learning and Development Standards and Common Core.

#### **Focus**

To expand the use of the Project Approach into Chicago and Chicago suburb public schools in preschool through third grade classrooms through professional development and field trip opportunities.

#### **Audience**

Preschool through third grade teachers who teach children in underserved communities in the Chicago and Chicagoland area.

#### **Application Procedures**

All teachers must submit an application form signed by the school principal to participate in the project. Applications will be reviewed and teachers will be informed of their participation by <u>June 1, 2017.</u>

#### **Activities**

Participate in Three Professional Development Workshops (Wednesdays).
 Participating providers must attend all three workshops October 25<sup>th</sup>, December 13<sup>th</sup>, and April 18<sup>th</sup> (8:30-3:30) - Substitutes will be paid for by the museum.
 Please go through schools normal procedures to arrange a substitute. Schools

will need to invoice the museum for substitute reimbursement, CPS schools will receive a bucket number.

- 2. **Participate in Evaluation and Assessment**: Museum Project Staff will **observe** participant's home/center prior to the project and after the projects' completion. In addition, participants will be required to complete project descriptions, staff development evaluations, and pre and post project attitude surveys.
- 3. **Plan, design, conduct and document** a child-centered project between October 2017 through March 2018. Additional support for conducting a project in the classroom will be provided by Museum education staff, including visits to the classroom if necessary.
- 4. **Select and purchase project materials.** Each teacher will receive \$250 worth of materials to support their projects. Materials are ordered through Kohl Children's Museum and must support project work done in the classroom.
- Schedule and attend one Focused Field Trip to Kohl Children's Museum (October 2017 – February 2018). All field trip and bus fees will be paid for through the project.
- 6. **Schedule, coordinate, and conduct one Parent/Child Activity** (Activity kit provided by the museum)
- 7. **Schedule and participate in one Project Celebration (Weekend) at Kohl Children's Museum** (May 5<sup>th</sup> or May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018) Bus fees, if needed, will be paid for by the museum. (Teachers are required to schedule the buses and to bring their project documentation to display at the Museum).
- 8. **Distribute Kohl Children's Museum Passes** to families of children involved in the project.
